INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA RELATED TO RELATIONS WITH POTENTIAL SUPPLIERS AND WITH SUPPLIERS

The following information is destined for people, including professional parties, the owners of individual concerns and agents/ company representatives, entities, associations and foundations, hereinafter "data subjects".

Identity and contact details of the process Controller

Data categories and their sources

Miche processes personal data of a common nature (e.g. name and address, contact data, data related to identification/recognition documents, data related to working activities, including certificates and professional qualifications), special data (e.g. data related to work suitability) and/or data related to criminal sentences, crimes and safety measures: this information may be collected from the subject it refers to and/or be collected from third parties (e.g. other company employees and collaborators of the company or the Criminal Records Office).

Purpose and legal basis

- A. Management of the pre-contractual stage:** personal data are processed for all needs connected to obtaining information and/or estimates.
- B. Management of the contractual stage:** personal data are processed for all needs linked to managing the contractual relationship during all its stages (e.g. managing appointments, organising logistics and fulfilling the legal obligations of the Controller).
- C. Defence purposes:** the Controller may need to process personal data to manage any disputes and out-of-court or legal litigation.

Storage period

Purposes	Storage time
A.	Time needed to obtain requests made and subsequent interactions.
B.	10 years from when the contract ceases.
C.	10 years from the final resolution of the dispute.

Nature of data provision and the consequences of a refusal

Purposes	Nature	Consequences
A.	Needed	Unable to ask for and obtain information needed.
B.	Needed	Unable to start or continue the commercial relationship.
C.	Needed	Impossible to manage the dispute.

Area of communication

The data are processed by internal personnel authorised to perform specific tasks and are communicated externally based on the following rules

Purposes	External recipient categories
A.	Companies belonging to the same business group, external consultants.
B.	Companies belonging to the same business group, credit institutions, external consultants, parties for which the communications are obligatory by law, commercial partners (customers/suppliers).

C. Legal firms; Legal authorities.

Seeing that the data are also processed using computer tools, they could also be visible to parties performing assistance/maintenance on those systems.

Transfer of data to a third country or an international organisation

The Controller does not transfer personal data outside the European Economic Area.

Rights of the data subjects

The subjects the personal data refer to are acknowledged the following rights:

Access: they can be informed as to whether their personal data are being processed and, if so, have access to them and request a copy.

Rectification: they may ask for the personal data to be updated, corrected (if incorrect) and integrated if not complete.

Erasure: they may have the personal data erased in certain situations (for more information contact the Controller).

Restriction: they may ask for their data to be marked, in order to restrict any further processing, in certain situations (for more information contact the Controller).

Object: they may object to the processing of their personal data, for reasons connected to a specific situation, when processing is based on legitimate interest or is needed to perform a task of public interest or connected to exercising the public powers that the Controller is assigned.

Portability: they can receive the personal data supplied to the Controller in a structured form and transmit them to another processing controller if the processing is based on consent or contract and is performed by automated means.

Revoke consent: they may revoke consent for purposes that required it, without prejudice to the legality of processing performed until that moment.
